- ★ Drop & Go to still operate in the morning at front gate (If parents/carers wish) or back playground
- ★ There is a green line in the back playground which indicates a child/school staff zone only
- ★ Teachers will greet children in the morning and not liaise with parents/carers unless there is an emergency
- ★ A bell will ring at 8.45am which signals remaining parents/carers leave and children file into school
- ★ No use of the outside gym or children on the school field
- ★ Wraparound times will remain the same
