I as a Parent/Carer will:

- Make sure that my child will arrive at school by the designated start time.
- Inform the school, by telephone or MyChildAtSchool, when my child is absent.

- Use ParentPay for all payments. Endeavour to stay up to date with any fees and costs and understand that failure to do this, may result in legal action.
- If I have any concern, I will contact the relevant staff member and be willing to resolve the issue informally in the first instance. If not satisfied, I will follow the Trust's formal complaints process which can be found on the school website.
- Refrain from using social networking sites to discuss sensitive issues relating to the school. In particular, I will refrain from discussing any matters of complaint on social networking sites.
- Support school policies on digital technology and the internet. I will monitor my child's use of the internet and social media outside of school. I will also act as a positive role model and will use social media responsibly in respect of all matters relating to the school.
