This term, our topic is 'What happens in spring?'.
At Bright Sparks Nursery, the children will be learning about the seasonal changes associated with spring. They will explore the local environment, observing and identifying emerging plant life such as the first green shoots of daffodils and crocuses, and the blossom appearing on trees. Group discussions will cover the weather patterns of spring, including the increasing temperatures, longer daylight hours, and the balance of sunny days and spring showers which contribute to new growth.

The children will also learn about animals commonly born in springtime, such as lambs, chicks, and ducklings.

World Book Day is also celebrated this term - how exciting! We will be taking part in lots of activities that promote our love of reading, such as going on a trip to our school library and dressing up as our favourite book characters!
