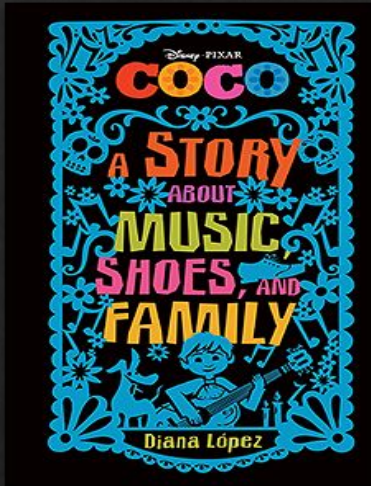


Day of The Dead

Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to concentrate on calculation, learning written methods of addition and subtraction. We will then be learning about measurement with a focus on area. We will also consolidate multiplication and division calculations as well as our times tables.



English

This term, Year 4 will be reading *Coco - A story about music, shoes and family* by Diana Lopez. We will be using this as a focus for our writing, which will be in the genres of a narrative, police report and instructions.

Science

The children will be learning about States of Matter where we will be grouping and comparing materials. Children will carry out observations into whether materials can change state when they are heated or cooled. This will then lead our learning into the water cycle.

Geography

This term Year 4 will be recapping our understanding of continents and oceans before learning about North American countries and cities.

Spanish

We will learn about weather and descriptions of seasons.

PE

This term's PE will be rugby and hockey with Miss Horn and Mrs Winchester. Mrs Stewart will continue with gymnastics.

PSHE

This term we will be celebrating difference! Children will learn about assumptions and think about what influences our assumptions. Our learning will touch upon bullying linking nicely to anti-bullying week.
